General Duties and Responsibilities

- Ensure that the flower baskets at the Practice Tee pavilion are watered daily.
- Assist with Practice Facility takedown to prepare for mowing and setup following mowing. This includes moving furniture and other Practice Tee accessories to and from the Practice Tee area.
- Completes other tasks/duties as assigned.
