



Dear Eagle County Junior Golfers,

Eagle Ranch Golf Club Junior Golf programming for the 2019 summer is full of fun and exciting camps, leagues, tournaments, and competitions. Please see the rest of this packet for information on each program and get ready for the best summer of golf ever at Eagle Ranch!

The First Tee Junior Golf Camps:

Eagle Ranch Golf Club will again be offering our Par and Birdie camps. Camps will focus on golf skills, life skills, and other games and fitness activities to engage the kids and encourage safety, fun and learning in a golf setting.

Par Camps \$75 – are designed for kids who are just getting into golf and don't have much on course experience.

Birdie Camps \$125 – are designed for kids who have both golf and on course experience. Coaches from previous years, let their students know when they are qualified for the Birdie Camp.

First Tee Girls Night Out Schedule

Girls Night Out \$125 – is a junior camp for **GIRLS ONLY**, of all abilities. This camp will teach the kids the different aspects of the golf swing, rules, etiquette, and some on course time.

PGA Junior League:

In 2011, the PGA of America launched a national program called PGA Junior League. The concept was to create something like baseball's Little League, but for golf. This program has seen tremendous growth throughout the country and in Colorado.

Two different leagues will be offered to our junior golfers. The 13-U program is for junior golfers 13 years old and younger and the 17-U program is for junior golfer between 14 & 17.

The 13-U league will participate on a team of 10-12 players, receive weekly instruction from a PGA Golf Professional, and will have the opportunity to play other courses in weekly matches here in Eagle County. Our teams will have a one-hour practice each week. Kids will have the option of playing 9 holes after practice. The PGA Coach will pair the kids into groups and check on their progress during their round.

Matches will be on Monday's at 3pm throughout June and July. The nine-hole matches will usually take about 2 ½ - 3 hours to complete. Parents are responsible for providing transportation to each event. The event schedule will be finalized after team registration is complete in May.

Finally, we want to encourage a strong level of commitment and participation from our players and parents. To make this program successful, we all need to be able to field full teams for each event. Parents are needed to help supervise a group during competitions as they players from each team will be spread between 4 or 5 foursomes. Parents are encouraged to participate as spectators (from the cart path).

There is an opportunity for some of the kids to move on to compete at a larger regional level and even potentially play in a National Championship.

The deadline to register is May 1st.

The 17-U league is a more individual based program. Each junior will get four thirty-minute private lessons with their PGA Golf Professional coach and will have the opportunity to play other courses in weekly individual matches against other juniors in Eagle County.

Matches will be on Monday's at 3pm throughout June and July. The nine-hole matches will usually take about 2 ½ - 3 hours to complete. Parents are responsible for providing transportation to each event. The event schedule will be finalized after team registration is complete in May.

The deadline to register is May 31st.

The cost of both leagues is \$250 per junior!

Drive Chip & Putt Championship:

In 2013 the Drive, Chip, and Putt Championship was created by the Masters Tournament, USGA, and The PGA of America. The Drive, Chip and Putt Championship is a free nationwide junior golf development competition aimed at growing the game by focusing on the three fundamental skills of golf. The competition is for girls and boys ages 7-15. The Drive, Chip and Putt Championship provides junior golfers an opportunity to play with their peers in qualifiers around the country. Participants who advance through local, sub-regional and regional qualifying in each age/gender category earn a place in the National Finals, which is conducted at Augusta National Golf Club the Sunday before the Masters Tournament and is broadcast live by Golf Channel. **Eagle Ranch Golf Club will be hosting a Drive, Chip, and Putt Championship on Monday, June 22nd .**

Eagle Ranch Adult/Junior Golf Tournament:

Eagle Ranch Golf Club will host two Adult/Junior Tournaments during the 2019 summer. These events are designed for golfers of all abilities. The whole idea is to have fun. The only restriction is that the junior golfer must be 17 years old or younger. Dinner, prizes, and a raffle will follow play, which is included in the fee.

- Format:** 9-Hole 2-Person Scramble (one Adult with one Junior)
- Age Groups:** 6 to 8 (Play from 150-yard post)

12 to 14 (Play the Red Tees)
15 to 17 (Boys play the Blue Tees and Girls play the Red Tees)
- Entry Fee:** Passholders per person \$25
Non-passholders per person \$45

Junior Season Passes

Standard Junior Memberships will no longer be sold. We are encouraging our junior golfers to join the Junior Golf Alliance of Colorado's Youth on Course membership. Details are on the next page.

Premium Junior Membership:

- **Town of Eagle - \$375 or Eagle County - \$475**
- Ages 18-under, must prove age with Driver's License or Birth Certificate
- Unlimited play during weekdays and restricted before 1:00pm on weekends during the Peak Season
- Unlimited individual use of the driving range
- No advance tee times, reservations may only be made on the day of play or on walk-in basis
- Skills & etiquette test must be passed prior to purchase. The ability to play at an appropriate pace must be demonstrated

Student Junior Membership:

- **Town of Eagle - \$650 or Eagle County - \$750**
- Ages 19 to 23, must prove age with Driver's License or Birth Certificate
- Unlimited play during weekday and restricted before 1:00pm on weekends during Peak Season
- Unlimited individual use of the driving range
- No advance tee times, reservations may only be made on the day of play or on walk-in basis

Junior Golf Alliance of Colorado – Youth on Course Membership:

The Junior Golf Alliance of Colorado partnered with Youth on Course (YOC) to create an affordable way for juniors to play golf. YOC Membership must be between the ages of 6 – 18. **The cost is \$25** and includes the below benefits:

- \$5 Green Fee at all 900 plus participating golf courses (different restrictions apply to each course) YOC members will have to comply with our General Junior Golf Policies.
- Bag of Small range balls with every round
- GHIN Handicap
- Opportunities in YOC Caddie Program
- Opportunities for Paid Highschool Internship
- Opportunities for College Scholarships

General Junior Golf Policies:

- Junior golfers who **DO NOT** have a Junior Membership, First Tee/PGA Jr. League bag tag, or youth on course membership pay a \$20 green fee for 9 or 18 holes.
- Must pay a cart fee in addition to the green fee, if they are riding a cart.
- Must have a valid driver's license to drive a cart.
- May only make tee times after 2:00pm on the day they wish to play.
- May only play prior to 2:00pm if accompanied by a paid adult.
- Must display proper golf etiquette at all times. Eagle Ranch Golf Course reserves the right to suspend playing privileges for improper conduct.
- Junior golfers between the ages of 5 - 11 must be accompanied by an adult on the golf course.
- **Children 4 years or younger are prohibited from being on the course.**
- **Children between 5 – 17 years old can be on the golf course as a non-playing spectator but must pay a cart fee if riding in a golf cart.**

First Tee/PGA Junior League Golf Privileges:

First Tee/PGA Jr. League Participants get the following privileges:

- One free large bag of range balls per day.

First Tee Participants must check in to the Golf Shop with their First Tee of Eagle County Bag Tag to receive these privileges each time. They will be given a receipt to show to the Practice Tee Attendant or the Starter.

Private Junior Golf Lessons:

- Individual – 30 Minute Lesson - \$40
- Individual - 1 Hour Lesson - \$70
- Individual – Four 30 Minute Lesson Package - \$120
- Individual – Four 1 Hour Lesson Package - \$210
- 2 to 3 Juniors – 30 Minute Lesson - \$60
- 2 to 3 Juniors – 1 Hour Lesson - \$100
- 4 to 5 Juniors – 30 Minute Lesson - \$80
- 4 to 5 Juniors – 1 Hour Lesson - \$150
- 2 to 3 Juniors – Four 30 Minute Lesson Package - \$180
- 2 to 3 Juniors – Four 1 Hour Lesson Package - \$300
- 4 to 5 Juniors – Four 30 Minute Lesson Package - \$240
- 4 to 5 Juniors – Four 1 Hour Lesson Package - \$450
